### Feb 29, We Departure

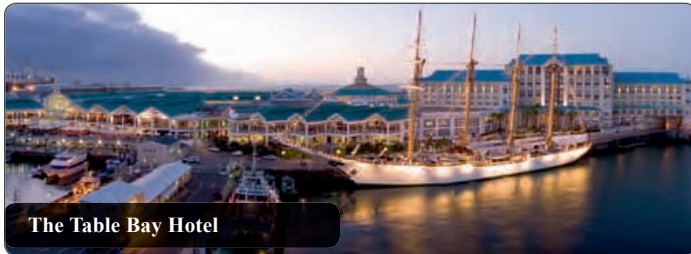
Board your wide-body jet this morning, with complimentary inflight entertainment and gluten-free meals onboard.

### Mar 1, Th Arrival in Victoria Falls L,D

After a brief connection in Johannesburg, arrive in Victoria Falls where you will be met and transferred to the Victoria Falls Hotel (or similar). Welcome.

### Mar 2, Fr Victoria Falls B,L,D

Enjoy a guided walking tour of the falls, one of the 7 natural wonders of the world. Optional activities this afternoon include a helicopter flight over the falls, an elephant back safari, and other options.

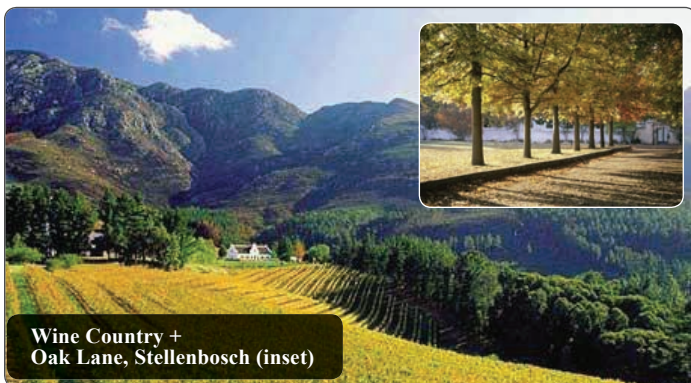


### Mar 3, Sa Fly to Capetown B,L,D

After a leisurely morning, you will be collected at your hotel and transferred to the airport for your flight to Capetown (connection in Johannesburg). Upon arrival in Capetown, you'll be met and transferred to the Table Bay Hotel (or similar) on the V&A Waterfront.

### Mar 4, Su City, Cape of Good Hope B,L,D

Savor the breathtaking view from the top of Table Mountain. Visit Cape Point, then drive along the coast to see the amazing penguin colony at Boulders Beach and stop by trendy Kalk Bay.



### Mar 5, Mo Wine Country B,L,D

Stellenbosch is South Africa's second oldest city and this oak-lined university town is a living architectural treasure. Enroute to a picturesque vineyard to sample some of South Africa's world-renowned wines, you'll drive past the Victor Verster Prison from where Nelson Mandela was released in 1994. Also visit the So. African Museum. Balance of day free.

### Mar 6, Tu Fly to Jo'burg & Kruger B,L,D

Morning flight to Johannesburg and connect to the brief flight to Hoedspruit. You'll be met and transferred to your suite at Kapama River Lodge (or similar).

### Mar 7-9 Kapama River Lodge B,L,D

There are a number of ways to view the wildlife, from the unparalleled panorama off the viewing deck of your lodge to the guided game walks and drives. The area is marked by its diversity, from leopards and lion that own the opens spaces to the herds engaged in the ebb and flow of the African bush. You're in the heart of "Big 5" country! The days and nights here are shared with the animals, the sounds and smells of So. Africa.

Activities at the lodge include morning and afternoon game drives and optional bush walks. The game drives are conducted in open Land Rover vehicles with experienced rangers and game trackers. Relax at the pool between drives or enjoy an optional spa treatment.

A final morning game drive before breakfast and packing. After lunch, fly to Johannesburg where you'll proceed to international departures to check in for your nonstop transAtlantic flight this evening.

Air transportation: scheduled IATA airline on round-trip group fare to Capetown and return from Johannesburg, and all internal flights, as indicated.

Accommodations: incl. all hotel taxes and service charges

All meals: special gluten-free breakfast, lunch and dinner daily, table d'hote basis, incl. taxes and service charges

Special events & sightseeing: via air-conditioned bus with English speaking guides; all entrance fees incl.

Game drives in Kruger

Transfers between airports, piers, terminals and hotels, via chartered air-conditioned coach incl. portorage of 1 piece of hand luggage per person
